## HOME FAMILY HOUSING VOUCHER PROGRAM APPENDIX D. RENTAL UNIT SIZE

The HOME Family Housing Voucher Program is responsible for determining the rental unit size for each household approved for the program. Rental unit size is determined based on household size. The following chart shows the rental unit size by the number of persons in the household:

| <b>Rental Unit Size</b> | Persons in Household |
|-------------------------|----------------------|
| 1 Bedroom               | 1-2                  |
| 2 Bedrooms              | 2-4                  |
| 3 Bedrooms              | 3-6                  |
| 4 Bedrooms              | 4-8                  |
| 5 Bedrooms              | 6-10                 |

The applicant will be allowed one bedroom for each two persons within the household, except in the following circumstances:

- Persons of different generations and unrelated adults will be allocated a separate bedroom.
- Live-in aides will be allocated a separate bedroom.

\* Children in the custody of the Department for Children and Families not currently living with the family, but likely to be reunified within 180 days will be included in the household for the purposes of determining rental unit size.
